

Premier 18-Hole, Par 72 Luxury Putting Carpet

OFFICIAL RULES

- 1. The official American Putting Classic course is 36 square feet (3' X 12'). Both participation and scoring are on the honor system. In tournament competition, the number of rounds played is determined by the Tournament Coordinator.
- 2. Each player is allowed 6 practice putts. We recommend 2 short putts, 2 medium range and 2 long putts.
- 3. Your entire round consists of 18 putts from the 18 marked tees. You begin by placing your ball on white marked tee #1. Your ball must be completely inside the marker on each hole before you putt. After your first putt you continue with longer putts #2 through #9 (they are all marked in white). This will give you a nine hole score. You will complete your score by continuing on hole #10 (the back nine marked in yellow) and continue on holes #11 through #18.
- 4. Your putt must go <u>directly into the hole</u> to be counted made. <u>It cannot be banked</u> from any angle.
- 5. All tournament rounds must be registered on our official scorecard. It will show you automatically what your score is on each hole. The 18 holes and scores are:

<u>Holes # 1,2,10 & 11 – Par 3's –</u> make you get Par 3 – miss you get bogey 4 no birdies on par 3's.

<u>Holes # 3,4,5,6,7,12,13,14,15 &16 - Par 4's</u> – make you get birdie 3 – miss you get bogey 5.

Holes # 8,9,17 & 18 – Par 5's – make you get eagle 3 – miss you get bogey 6.

- A perfect game (make all 18 putts) your final score would be 54. Play and (miss all 18 putts) your final score would be 90. The course is designed and set up for your score to closely represent what is shot on junior, collegiate and professional tours.
- 7. Each round of golf (2,3, or 4 players) should be completed in less than 12 minutes. Slow play is discouraged and penalties should be determined by the tournament coordinator or players in the group.
- 8. In tournament play or practice, avoid stepping or jumping on the raised foam supported area around the golf hole.
